ARE ALL THESE IN PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD?

Jesus taught: If I don’t confess faith in Jesus as God the _____, then my sin separates me from God the _____ too, and I am not in personal relationship with God (John 8:34-47).

Through the sacrifice system of the Jews, God made one point clear: Sin means _____.

A *Go’el* (redeemer) is needed who can remove the sin and its consequences in order for us to be in personal relationship with God. Through the Law, God taught the Hebrew people that only a kinsman (relative) could qualify as a *Go’el* (see Leviticus 25:24-5, 48-9; Ruth 3:13; Numbers 35:19). But “no man can by any means redeem his brother, or give to God a ransom for him...” (Psalm 49:6). *Why?* All have sinned and are under bondage to it. Then God announced that He would be our *Go’el* (Isaiah 43:1). But how? Only a kinsman (human) can qualify to redeem. So God became flesh as Jesus Christ to be both qualified as a man and adequate to redeem (without sin). He became our *Go’el* to “give His life a ransom for many” (Mark 10:45).

Jesus taught: If I don’t have _____,
then I’m not in personal relationship with God and will not have eternal life in heaven (John 3:3).

"He died once for the sins of all us guilty sinners, although He Himself was innocent of any sin at any time, that He might bring us safely home to God" (1 Peter 3:18).

"It is a trustworthy statement, deserving full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" (1 Timothy 1:15; also Romans 5:8; Mark 10:45; 1 Timothy 1:15; 1 Pet. 2:24).
